The lodge tyled at 6.30pm and was opened in due and solemn form by the Acting Worshipful Master at 6.41pm.

The minutes of the last regular meeting having been previously circulated to all members, were confirmed and the WM and wardens signed them off as a true and correct record.

There followed a ballot for initiation of Mr Stephen Redfern, aged 53, of 70 Hazel Hall lane, Higher Summerseat, Bury BL0 9UP, a Photographer. The ballot proved unanimous in the candidate's favour. WBro David Kyme replaced WBro Gareth Bradshaw in the chair of King Solomon.

Following a dispensation from the APGM, WBro John Griffin, there was an alarm and Mr Redfern ("the candidate") entered the Lodge for the ceremony of his initiation. The candidate answered the A/WM's questions, and his Obligation was taken. The Candidate was then initiated into freemasonry by the A/WM who was ably assisted by his Wardens and Deacons. (A/JD). In Any Other Business, WBro David Kyme proposed that Bro Paul John Holt, a former member of Egerton Lodge No. 1392, become a joining member. The proposition was seconded by WBro Gareth Bradshaw.

WBro Gareth Bradshaw proposed, and Bro Chris Boardman seconded that the Lodge donate the sum of £250 to the charity KidsCan. The proposition was carried unanimously.
